The 7 Critical Warning Signs Of Speech & Learning Disorders & How They Affect Your Child!

1. Does your child have trouble with reading?

Squinting while reading and holding the book up close to the eyes, are two things to watch out for. They may mean some form of eye trouble, but in many cases it's simply the fact that your child is having trouble comprehending what he or she is reading.

2. Does your child have trouble communicating effectively?

Poor communication leads to a troubled and confused child. Unclear speech, sentences that don't make sense, and not understanding others are all signs that you child is having trouble communicating. Below is a guide so you can judge if your child's speech and communication skills are progressing normally.

Between birth and three years your child will attempt:

- Lip sounds: p,b,m,w
- Tongue tip sounds: t,d,n
- Back of mouth sounds: k,g
- Other sounds: h,y

It's important to note that most children will say these sounds clearly by the time they are three.

Here's How To Help Your Child's Development:

Sucking, learning to bite and chew, as well as putting the odd item into their mouths are all important activities for your child to undertake.

That's because these behaviours help your child to become aware of the different mouths parts they possess and also it helps to control and change mouth positions... *this is an important learning step for your child.*

By four and a half years, your child will also attempt:

- Tongue tip sounds: s,z
- Middle of the mouth sounds: sh, ch
- Other sounds: l, j, f

Most children can be easily understood by this age. However, if your child is tired, a bit off colour, or just plain excited, then of course his or her speech will be less clear.

Here's How To Help Your Child's Development:

Singing, playing rhyming games, playing and reading books are all fun ways to help your child sort out different word and sound patterns. Even just talking and playing with other children will help your child's normal development.

By eight and a half years your child can say:

- All of the sounds clearly.
- The last sounds to develop are: v, th, r

It's important to note that some children may take extra time to blend all of the sounds together. Especially with such words as <u>tree</u>, <u>plane</u>, desk and so on.

Here's How To Help Your Child's Development:

Reading to your child every day, interacting with him or her, and generally just listening and talking about their day, will help your child to develop normally.

3. Does your child have a stutter?

Stuttering can be emotionally damaging to your child. Often children who stutter are ridiculed and bullied at school... they become the scapegoat for teasing. While many different and sometimes complex things can cause stuttering, the GOOD NEWS is this problem can be managed with the proper guidance.

4. Does your child have trouble with spelling?

Trouble with spelling may mean your child is having difficulty with learning and may not be progressing normally as he or she should. Help is at hand and this problem can be managed.

Here's How To Help Your Child's Development:

Spending time with your child and helping him or her with their homework, is a good way to get in there and assist your child's development. And I know as a parent you are busy with 101 other things that need doing. But you'll be amazed what a few minutes each day spent with your child will do for your child's confidence. And confident children make better students.

5. Is your child learning English as a second language?

Understandably, children in bilingual families, or who are learning more than one language, may need longer to learn the sounds to effectively communicate. That's because there are more sounds to learn in each language and this can sometimes cause problems.

If your child is in this situation and is having trouble, he or she may...

- Become irritable while learning
- May be hard to understand
- May say an easier sound for a more difficult one such as: tar for car, wing for ring.

Here's How To Help Your Child's Development:

Just remember your child is learning a lot more than other kids who have just the one language to learn. This may mean extra time must be spent with your child reading, listening and talking to help your child overcome any difficulties.

6. Is your child getting teased or bullied at school?

In my experience, the longer bullying goes on, the worse it gets. It seems to escalate the longer it goes on. Not only that, children who are bullied become emotionally scarred and withdrawn, and these problems often show up in later life with disastrous results. Many have issues to deal with in their adult lives.

Here's How To Help Your Child's Development:

If your child is being bullied at school talk to his or her teacher. If need be, talk to the principal and make sure you get some answers. Bullying cannot be tolerated and many schools have strict policies on such matters. The trouble is, many times children don't tell their parents what's going on. They may be afraid or ashamed to talk to you about this problem. So if you have any concerns, ask your child. If you can't get any answers then see his or her teacher.

7. Is your child lagging behind the rest of the class because of difficulties with classwork?

To succeed in today's competitive world, your child needs all the support and love and education he or she can get.
